Dear Member,

If you were allocated a grant through the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CVRF), you may still have funds available for reimbursement or use in claims related to COVID-19. To check your current grant status or remaining balance, contact <u>Colorado's Department of Local Affairs (DOLA)</u> directly.

## The CARES Act which established the CVRF may reimburse Special Districts, Counties, and Municipalities for costs that were:

- necessary expenditures incurred due to the COVID-19 public health emergency (COVID-19 emergency);
- 2. not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State; and
- 3. incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 31, 2021.

Increased Workers' Compensation costs due to the COVID–19 public health emergency incurred during the period listed above also qualify as an eligible expense. **This extends to first responders and critical health care workers that contracted COVID-19.**
